



WELCOME ROCK RIVER VISITORS

Rock River is a tributary of the West River, running its entire course within Windham County, VT. The River provides essential habitat to a wide range of plants, animals and aquatic life, which depend on a clean water environment. As the river winds downstream, it has also traditionally provided sanctuary and solace to a varied group of users who prize the cool, clean water and warm rocks for summertime recreation. ROCK RIVER PRESERVATION, INC., in partnership with the VERMONT LAND TRUST, is committed to protecting this natural environment through a Conservation Easement. We users are all the caretakers of this special place. To insure that the environment remains healthy, everyone's rights are respected, and all may enjoy the tranquil beauty of this special place, please join us in observing the following guidelines:

- Respect privacy of adjacent landowners; stay on designated trail and beaches.
- Carry out all trash, including cigarette butts, foodstuffs and remnants thereof.
- Open fires prohibited without permission of the Newbrook Fire Department. If you build a fire, make sure it is completely out when you leave.
- Keep soap and detergent out of the river
- There are no sanitary facilities at Rock River. Please plan accordingly.
- No camping without permission of landowners.
- Do not cut live trees.
- Leash all dogs and clean up after their mess.
- Refrain from playing radios, tape and CD players; no mechanized sounds.
- Always obtain the consent of subject(s) before taking photos or filming.
- Get dressed when leaving established "clothing optional" areas; respect the rights of private property owners and other beach users.
- Police periodically patrol the Rock River trail and beaches. If you are engaged in illegal activities, you can be banned from the property for life!
VT Chapter 59, Section 2601: Lewd and Lascivious Conduct. A person guilty of open and gross lewdness and lascivious behavior shall be imprisoned not more than five years or fined not more than \$300.00 or both.
- You use this land and all its amenities at your own risk. Rock River Trail can be challenging in places; please hike cautiously and wear appropriate foot gear at all times.
